WALLYDALLENBACH PLANTED SEEDS FOR THE COLORADO 500 INTHE FALLOF 1975, WHENHE AND SHERM COOPER ENJOYED SEVERAL DAYS OF TRAVELING THE ROCKY MOUNTAIN TRAILS AND VISITING MINING GHOST TOWNSIN THE STATE.

THEY INVITED SEVEN FRIENDS TO JOIN THEM THE FOLLOWING YEAR TO RIDE SAME BACKCOUNTRY TRAILS. THAT GROUP OF NINE, WHICH INCLUDED AUTO-RACING LUMINARIES AL AND BOBBY UNSER, COMPOSED THE FIELD OF THE FIRST COLORADO 500 DIRT BIKE RIDE.

WALLY AND HIS WIFE PEPPY DEDICATED THEMSELVES TO HOSTING THE ANNUAL EVENT, AND AS THE GUEST LIST GREW SO DID INTEREST IN A STREET BIKE RIDE WHICH FORMULATED IN 1987 CALLED THE COLORADO 500 CHARITY INVITATIONAL ROAD RIDE HELD IN JUNE WHICH HAS GROWN IN THE SAME STAGES.

AS OF 2018 THE ROAD RIDE MERGED TOGETHER WITH THE AUGUST EVENT CREATING A RIDE FOR LOVERS OF DIRT, ROAD AND ADVENTURE BIKES.

Fundraising Goal: The goal is to raise \$75,000 per year for the next 2-years bringing a total of \$225,000 over the three year period.


